Search Strategies to Find
a Quantitative Research Article on Conflict in Business
&
a Qualitative Research Article on Conflict in the Family

Use the EMU database *ProQuest PowerSearch*

For Quantitative Research Articles on Conflict in Business

1. Below the search boxes, look for a line beginning **Limit to:**, place a check next to **Peer reviewed**
2. Below the search boxes, look for a box with the heading **Language:**, place a check next to **English**
3. In the search box toward the top of the page type (with the asterisks):
business or employ* or personnel or manager* or work*
at the end of the first line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text - NOFT** to **All subjects & indexing - SU**
4. In the first search box on the second search line, type:
conflict
at the end of the line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text - NOFT** to **All subjects & indexing - SU**
5. Below the second search line, click the link saying **Add a row**
6. In the first search box on the third search line, type:
quantitative
at the end of the line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text - NOFT** to **All subjects & indexing - SU**
7. Below the third search line, click the link saying **Add a row**
8. Type in the search box: **us**
9. At the end of the fourth search line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text – NOFT** to **Location – LOC**
10. Below the fourth search line, click the link saying **Add a row**
11. Before the search box, change the drop down menu from the default **AND** to **NOT**
12. In the first search box type **“family conflict”** or **“family work relationship”**
13. Click the **Search** button

For Qualitative Research Articles on Conflict in the Family

1. Below the search boxes, look for a line beginning **Limit to:**, place a check next to **Peer reviewed**

famil* or mother* or father* or spouse* or sibling* or parent*
at the end of the first line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text - NOFT** to **All subjects & indexing - SU**
4. In the first search box on the second search line, type:
conflict
at the end of the line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text - NOFT** to **All subjects & indexing - SU**
5. Below the second search line, click the link saying **Add a row**
6. In the first search box on the third search line, type:
qualitative
at the end of the line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text - NOFT** to **All subjects & indexing - SU**
7. Below the third search line, click the link saying **Add a row**
8. Type in the search box: **us**
9. At the end of the fourth search line, change the drop down menu from **Anywhere except full text - NOFT** to **Location – LOC**
10. Click the **Search** button
