Download and Register Zotero

1. Download the Zotero standalone client on the Windows, Mac, or Linux operating systems.
2. Download a Zotero Connector for your browser, i.e., Chrome, Firefox, Opera, or Safari

3. Register for free Zotero user account

Setting Up Zotero

1. **Sync Zotero account with desktop Zotero**
Edit>>Preferences>>Sync

2. **Select/update citation styles**
Edit>>Preferences>>Cite>>Styles>>Get Additional Styles

3. **Select default quick copy citation style**

Adding Items to Zotero

http://www.zotero.org/support/getting_stuff_into_your_library

1. Via icons in the browser address bar
2. Via right-click menu: Zotero Connector>>Save to Zotero
3. Via ISBN, DOI, PMID identifier
4. Via right-clicking PDF file dragged into Zotero center pane and selecting 'Retrieve Metadata for PDF'. If no metadata found, right-click PDF file and choose 'Create Parent Item' and add metadata manually
5. Via manually adding and editing items
6. Via importing other citation manager file types, e.g., RIS/Refer files
